

Croatia: Acciona to invest 90 MEUR in two wind farms, expansion in SEE region

Acciona is one of the leading companies in the sector of RES and infrastructure, with branches in more than twenty countries around the world and more than 35 thousand employees.

It has operated in Croatia more than ten years, and her first Croatian wind farm, Jelinak, near Split, worth 45 MEUR, put into operation in 2013th. Acciona also is the investor in this wind farm, but also wind turbines producer and supplier. It is a wind farm with installed capacity of 30 MW consisting of twenty turbines, making it the largest wind farm in the Split-Dalmatia county and one of the largest in Croatia. But the company's plans are more ambitious than that, and not only in Croatia.

In the next five years Acciona plans to complete two wind farms in Dalmatia with a total value of 90 MEUR, whose construction will began in 2016th, and they will spread to neighboring countries in which Acciona see great potential.
