

Croatian consumer goods distributor **Atlantic Group** said that it has commissioned its first [solar power plant](#) aimed at reducing energy costs and carbon dioxide emissions.

The statement from the company said that the annual **electricity generation of the Vukovina rooftop solar power plant** is estimated to about 440,000 kWh, while [CO2 emissions](#) will be reduced by 3,250 tons per year.

The 300 kW solar power plant was installed by local energy solutions provider **E.ON Solar**, consisting of 1,020 solar panels mounted on the rooftop of Vukovina distribution center in the capital Zagreb. The company expected the return on investment in just a year and a half.

The power plant will generate electricity for Atlantic Group's own consumption, with eventual surpluses being transferred to the national distribution network. The facility is the first in a series being a part of the company's green transformation.
