



More than 50 energy permissions for electricity production from renewable energy sources were issued only in the last five years and we don't have a kilowatt from these sources still, especially from wind parks which were so much talked about.

There were a lot of reasons for postponing: slow administration, confusing rules and nepotism during licenses' issuance.

The rules are little changed now so not everyone will be able to start the business. He or she will have to prove to be ready to finish it, previously.

We have only five active projects that are really close to construction of all announcements from Vojvodina.

Those companies managed to fight bureaucracy, to carry out complicated research and to find serious investors.

American Company "Continental wind" plans the construction of Wind Park with 57 piles in Kovin. If everything works alright, the work will start in the autumn and the first kilowatts will be produced at the end of 2014.

We only miss Governmental Law for "feed-in-tariffs" for privileged electricity producers, which is the only missing law at the moment.
