The trade agreements between Italy and Serbia in the energy sector made some energy companies favored and thanks to that they drew a very large financial gain, according to the Italian television RAI 3.

The website of this television station published a report in which investigates irregularities in in partner selection process in the projects carried out by the Italian government in Serbia in Montenegro in the field of energy and renewable energy.
