

Romania: Nuclearelectrica increased production output and profit 1Q 2015

Nuclearelectrica operates the Cernavoda nuclear plant, which provides nearly 20 percent of the national energy consumption, and its controlled by the state.

Electricity supplier Nuclearelectrica profit increased in 1Q 2015 by 11% compared to the one registered in the similar period of 2014, from EUR 7.95 million, the state company announced.

Revenues increased to EUR 105 million, from EUR 103.5 million, while exploitation expenses decreased to EUR 99.2 million and production decreased by 2 percent.

Nuclearelectrica operates the Cernavoda nuclear plant, which provides nearly 20 percent of the national energy consumption, and is controlled by the state, through the Ministry of Energy.

Nuclearelectrica, whose production was up by 0.5 percent last year and represented 18.4 percent of the national electricity total, registered in 2014 operational incomes amounting EUR 408.5 million, 12 percent less compared to EUR 450 million. , transmits Serbia-energy.eu
