

On 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016 (delivery date 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016), on the Serbian day-ahead exchange SEEPEX, trading was carried out at the price of 36.41 euros/MWh for daily basic load. The trading volume was 729.9 MWh.

The price of peak energy for daily peak load was at the level of 42.96 euros per MWh and the trading volume was 194.5 MWh.

On the Croatian day-ahead energy market CROPEX, trading was carried out at the price of 39.36 euros/MWh for daily basic load.

The price of peak energy for daily peak load was at the level of 43.87 euros per MWh. The total trading volume amounted to 297.0 MWh.

On the Romanian day-ahead energy market OPCOM, trading was carried out at the price of 35.78 euros/MWh for daily basic load.

The price of peak energy for daily peak load was at the level of 36.53 euros per MWh. The trading volume is 2,177.32 MWh.

During the off-peak hours, the price amounted to 36.55 euros per MWh, and the trading volume to 1,991.52 MWh.

On the Hungarian day-ahead energy market HUPX, trading was carried out at the price of 40.21 euros per MWh for daily basic load.

The price of peak energy for daily peak load was at the level of 45.63 euros per MWh. The total trading volume is 53,175.7 MWh.

On the Bulgarian exchange IBEX, the price for basic load was 42.15 euros per MWh.

The price of peak energy was 42.25 euros per MWh, and the trading volume was 4,307.1 MWh.

During the off-peak hours, the price amounted to 39.06 euros per MWh, and the trading volume to 3,873.7 MWh.
