On the Serbian day-ahead exchange SEEPEX on December 17, 2017 (delivery date: December 18, 2017) trading was carried out at the price of 103.82 EUR/MWh for daily baseload. Trading volume was 2,156.2 MWh.

The price of peak energy for daily peak load was 129.28 EUR/MWh and trading volume was 890.1 MWh.

On the Croatian day-ahead power market CROPEX trading was carried out at the price of 84.43 EUR/MWh for daily baseload.

The price of peak energy for daily peak load was at the level of 112.77 EUR per MWh.

Total trading volume was 362.0 MWh.

On the Romanian day-ahead power market OPCOM trading was carried out at the price of 73.05 EUR/MWh for daily baseload.

The price of peak energy for daily peak load was at the level of 96.53 EUR per MWh. Trading volume was 50,496.4 MWh.

During off-peak hours the price was 49.57 EUR per MWh, and trading volume was 46,702.7 MWh.

On Hungarian day-ahead power market HUPX trading was carried out at the price of 83.77 EUR per MWh for daily baseload.

The price of peak energy for daily peak load was at the level of 114.22 EUR per MWh.

Total trading volume was 59,398.6 MWh.

On Bulgarian exchange IBEX the price for baseload was 29.75 EUR per MWh.

The price of peak energy was 44.16 EUR per MWh, and trading volume was 3,748.3 MWh.

During off-peak hours the price was 15.34 EUR per MWh, and trading volume was 3,238.9 MWh.
