



The Serbian Ministry for Infrastructure has announced that it will go ahead with the creation of a successor national carrier to Jat Airways even if a strategic partner for the new venture is not found. The Ministry said it hopes to begin talks with Baltic Aviation Systems, the only enterprise to purchase the tender documentation for the creation of the new state carrier.

They have been given a month to send in their offer, after which "flexible" negotiations are set to take place in December. Baltic Aviation Systems is headed by a group of businessmen who partly own Latvia's national carrier, airBaltic.
