



Serbian SME's should take part in projects for the construction and revitalization of energy facilities in the country and the government will support them, Serbian Minister of Energy and Infrastructure Milutin Mrkonjic told reporters March 9, newswires reported. The electro-energy sector is Serbia's biggest development chance in the coming years and the government has the responsibility to remove obstacles that hinder opportunities for domestic enterprises to take part in such projects, he said.
