

Ukraine in January-June 2015 reduced the export of electricity to 2.6 times (2.875 billion kWh) compared to the same period in 2014 - up to 1.802 billion kWh.

Electricity supplies from Burshtyn TPP" in the direction of Hungary, Slovakia and Romania in the first half decreased by 20.5% (to 463.2 million kilowatt-hours) compared to the same period last year - up to 1 billion 795.6 million kW- h.

Electricity supplies to Poland for five months has not carried out, while during the same period last year were exported 598.7 million kWh of electricity.

In Belarus for the period delivered 0.4 million kWh to Moldova - 5.3 million kilowatt hours against 1 billion 402.6 million kWh and 416.8 million kilowatt-hours in January-June 2014, respectively.

Ukrainian electricity export to Russia for six months in 2015 amounted to 0.8 million kWh, while for the same period last year, supplies to Russia has not been fixed.

At the same time Ukraine in January-June 2015 imported 1 billion 392.9 million kWh of electricity from Russia, in Vol. H in June - 2.8 million kWh.

As reported, Ukraine in 2014 reduced the export of electricity by 18.4% (1 billion 817.9 million kilowatt-hours) compared with 2013 year - up to 8 billion 52.8 million kWh.

Deliveries of e / e in the Central European countries (Hungary, Slovakia, Romania and Poland) for the year amounted to 4 billion 921.2 million kilowatt-hours in Belarus - 2 billion 400.9 million kWh to Moldova - 730.7 million kWh.

Ukraine in 2014 exported 8.1 billion kWh of electricity in 2013 - 9.9 billion kilowatt-hours in 2012 - 9.7 billion kilowatt-hours in 2011 - 6.4 billion kWh, in 2010 - 4.2 billion kilowatt-hours in 2009 - 4.1 billion kilowatt-hours in 2008 - 7.9 billion kilowatt-hours in 2007 - 9.2 billion kWh in 2006 year - 10.4 billion kilowatt-hours in 2005 - 8.4 billion kWh.
